## Policy Statement On Provider Access



### **INTRODUCTION**

This policy statement sets out the academies arrangement for managing access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the academies legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

### **STUDENT ENTITLEMENT**

All pupils in years 8-12 are entitled:

- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical **courses**.
