Opportunities Live Visit - Thursday 6th March

I am writing to inform you that your child:

Has been successful in securing a place on the Opportunities live trip due to being one of the first 50 pupils to complete the online form.

The visit is free of charge and will take place on **Thursday 6th March 2025**.

On the day, students will be transported by coach, and will be accompanied by members of staff, from both Armthorpe Academy throughout the afternoon trip. The coach will depart from school at 12.30pm and return to the academy at approximately 2.45pm. **Students are required to attend in normal school uniform throughout the day and the trip.**

Due to the timing of the event being close to lunchtime, students who have been successful in securing a place will be able to go to lunch 15 minutes early, so that the coach can take students at 12.30pm.

All students attending are required to arrive at the normal start of the school day at 8.25am and will take part in normal lessons for period 1, 2 and 3. Students must then meet in the dining hall at 12.00pm in order to eat their lunch and be registered before getting on the coach.
