Dear Parents/Carers

As we approach the Easter break, we would like to offer a programme of Easter revision sessions to support students in preparing for their upcoming examinations. These sessions are designed to reinforce key concepts, build confidence, and provide targeted support in a structured and focused environment.

The revision sessions will take place over the Easter holidays and will be led by subject specialists. Students will have the opportunity to revisit challenging topics, practise exam-style questions, and receive personalised feedback to help maximise their progress. Attendance is strongly encouraged, particularly for students who would benefit from additional support or who are aiming to achieve higher grades. All sessions will be structured to ensure a balance between content review, independent practice, and guided support.
