Module One: Broadening Horizons Introduction to industry and the world of work, with a focus on the impact of

first impressions and key communication skills.



A creative session featuring special quests which involves interactive leadership challenges designed to build upon essential skills for employment.



Module Two: An Experience of Industry

A company-based session including a site tour and activities with quest presenters including the chance to 'Walk in my Shoes' with apprentices with a focus on character skills.

Module Four: The Ultimate Interview

Giving students the chance to find out what employers want with the opportunity to have mock interviews, CV workshops and learn about the different career paths our quests have followed. Session ends with a graduation ceremony and certificates.
