#### **Drinks Around School**

Following a few queries from parents regarding drinking, I'd just like to clarify the rules and reason for their inception. Water can be drunk in classrooms during lessons and at break and lunch time whilst students are sat in the dining areas. Food or drink cannot be consumed walking between lessons or in outside areas at social times. Choice behaviour has led to this decision. Sadly, despite several conversations with our students throughout the course of last term, we experienced continual problems with littering, which included food and drink bottles being discarded on the Astroturf and tennis courts despite several bins around the area. Students were given the opportunity to rectify this behaviour choice as a collective the rubbish left did not improve. The Astroturf and tennis courts are used as learning spaces, they are also leased for community use on an evening. Health and safety are paramount. Since the inception of the new rule, the playing areas are now much safer for everyone and there has been a significant reduction in litter around the school site. Just to clarify any misconceptions, students can move into and out of the dining area at will, but drinks will not be permitted on the Astroturf until our students learn that all unwanted food and drink and empty cartons must be disposed of appropriately in a bin. Our first school value is respect. We will re-evaluate once the canteen areas are at the standard all of us would expect in our own homes. Children are not being stopped from drinking. We are fortunate to have such a fantastic facility such as the Astroturf, but our students must learn to respect the environment, a life skill I am sure you also encourage and expect at home.
