Thank you for supporting us today by sending your child in PE kit and with plenty of water. We have been monitoring our classrooms throughout the course of the day. Given temperatures have risen considerably after 1pm, and in light of the anticipated higher temperatures tomorrow, **school will be closing at 12:50pm** (after P4).

Children entitled to a free school meal can collect a grab bag to take home with them or eat their food in school before they leave. The canteen will not be open to serve lunch.

Provision will be available in school for any students whose parents/carers need your son/daughter to be in school until our normal closing time of 2:45pm. If you would like your child to access this provision, please contact alison.whiteley@consilium-at.com to let us know.

This decision has been taken in collaboration with the trust's health and safety experts. As always, the safety of our school community is of paramount importance. I have also spoken with the Headteacher at Shaw Wood Academy, whom I am aware are closing at 1pm tomorrow. Our 12:50 finish will allow our students to collect younger siblings, if this is your usual medium of collection on an evening.

Classes will be re-roomed once again tomorrow to maximise use of the ventilation system in the new building. Please support us once again by encouraging your child to:

- Wear PE kit
- Apply suncream before they travel to school
- Wear a sunhat and sunglasses whilst outside
- Bring plenty of water in a refillable bottle

The weather is not forecast to be as hot on Wednesday, but an update will be emailed tomorrow evening.
