Whole school attendance

Whole school attendance dropped to 91% last week. Whilst we are aware there is genuine illness in the community, lateness is contributing significantly to diminishing attendance. Afternoon attendance is currently 1.5% higher than morning attendance – this is simply not acceptable. Students need to be in the school building by 8:25 to begin learning at 8:30. Any student arriving after this time is marked as late. This is particularly important for Year 10 and 11 students as attendance certificates are sent to college. Any student arriving after 9am is marked with a U code – this is unauthorised absence. As the end of term approaches, we will be contacting parents whose child/children are persistently late. Given we offer an alarm service, in our opinion a service above and beyond, there is no excuse or reason for any student to be persistently late.

Students with attendance above 95% this half term will be rewarded in the final week of term.

As always, thank you to the many families who do value the importance of attendance and are working with us to build resilience in the work place.

COVID

We are aware COVID infection rates are rising again in Doncaster. This is having an impact on both staff and student absence; some local schools have closed to certain year groups this week. In order to protect our school community, we will be activating phase one of our risk assessment from Monday. This means:

Year 11 will receive exam results from recent mock examinations on Friday. As part of the process, students will have the opportunity to reflect on areas of improvement, self-evaluate the effectiveness of revision and plan key next steps. As a school, we have invested heavily in buying revision guides for all students. These will also be distributed next Friday to help students' structure revision between now and the next mock examination window in March. There will be a Year 11 parents' evening on Thursday 2nd February. Over the course of the next two weeks, we will be contacting the parents of students who have under-performed across the curriculum who we need to see before Christmas. If you are not contacted, but would like to see a member of the leadership team about your child's progress, we will be running a drop-in session on Monday 12th December from 4pm until 6pm.
