## Re: Planned industrial strike action

I am sure you are aware that two further days of industrial action are planned for Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March next week. At this time, there is no indication of any plans to rescind the planned action and therefore the following provisional arrangements have been put in place.

All Year 11 will be in school on both days to complete key preparation for forthcoming practical GCSE assessments. More detailed information will follow in the newsletter this week.

Year 10 also have 'proper' GCSE assessments pending in vocational subjects that require 10 hours of assessed practical. Year 10 should therefore attend on the following days if they study:

I appreciate the industrial action next week will cause disruption to families and can only apologise for any inconvenience; as a school we are making the most of the resources we will have available.

Finally, you will also have seen there is potential heavy snow forecast over the next two days. We have contingency plans in place in the event of disruptive snow fall to ensure the site is safe for all.
