Year 9 1:1 Option Meetings

Just a reminder that Year 9 options meetings are taking place with families on Wednesday and Thursday this week after school. Industrial Action

You may have seen in the news that the teaching unions have indicated further industrial action will be taking place on **Thursday 27th April**.

- **Year 11 students will all be in school as normal.** It is imperative they attend. For art students, Thursday 27th is five hours of the allotted ten hours they are permitted for their final exam. The remainder of Year 11 will be working on a timetabled carousel of revision and coursework activities bespoke to them.
- **Year 10 students will also be in school all day.** Year 10 attendance on the last strike day was poor (less than 80%). This is a mandatory day at school, where although timetable might be slightly different, attendance is compulsory.
- **Work will be set for students in Year 7, 8 and 9 to complete at home.** A paper copy will be given to students at school on Wednesday with an email sent to parents on Wednesday evening.

Students entitled to a free school meal can collect a grab bag by walking into school to collect at 11am.
