Dear Parents and Carers

New College Doncaster Taster Day for Year 10 Students

We are writing to inform As you are aware your son/daughter is taking part in New College's Year 10 Taster Day event on **Tuesday 11th July 2023.** All students are required to arrive at the normal start of the school day, 8.25am, for registration and an outline of the day.

The visit will take place on Tuesday, 11th July. Students will attend their normal timetabled lessons periods 1 and 2, then after values students will meet in the canteen for an early lunch before being transported by coach, accompanied by members of staff, from both Armthorpe Academy and New College, departing school at 12:10pm and returning at approximately 2.45pm.

Timetable for the day:

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8.30am – 11am	Normal Timetabled lessons
11am	Students to meet in the canteen for an early lunch and debrief
12.10pm	Departure from Armthorpe Academy by coach
12.35pm	Arrival at New College
12.40pm – 2.30pm	2 x 40-minute Taster Sessions and a break
2.35pm	Departure from New College
2:45-3pm	Arrive back at Armthorpe Academy

Students are allowed to wear, college suitable, non-school uniform on the day to ensure that they get the full experience into college life. This visit is covered by the RVC (Regular Visit Consent) form you have previously completed for your child. If you have changed any of the emergency telephone contact details for your child in the last few weeks, please contact the academy office.

As this activity requires students to take responsibility and follow instructions, any student whose behaviour has not met school expectations this half term will be withdrawn from the activity. An opportunity will be available next year to supplement the curriculum.
