Planned Industrial Strike Action

School will be open on Wednesday 5th July for Year 7 and Year 10 students only

School will be open on Friday 7th July for Year 8 and Year 10 students only

Remote learning will be provided for students on Tuesday 4th July and emailed to parent/carers that evening, which must be completed on the days students are not in school.

If your child is entitled to a free school meal, a grab bag will be provided which can be collected from reception at 11am on the required day. If your child would like a grab bag, please contact Mrs McKinna (dawn.mckinna@consilium-at.com) no later than 1 pm on Tuesday 4th July.

School will be open as normal for all students on Monday 3rd, Tuesday 4th and Thursday 6th July.
