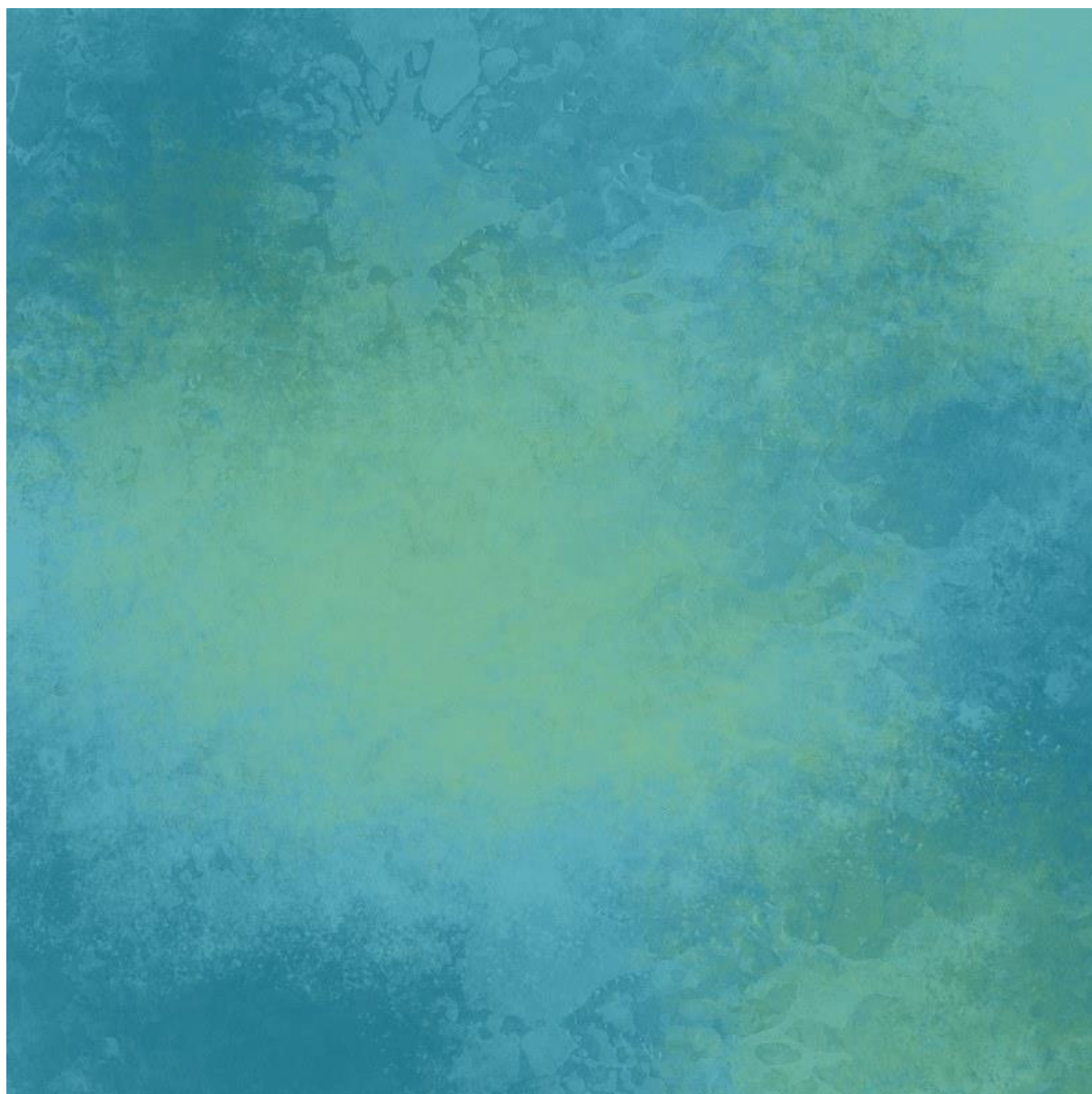
music lessons to our students. More details to follow shortly but again I'm really proud we can bring this back into our school.
