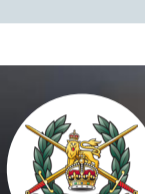

OFFICER FINANCIAL SUPPORT

FULLY FUNDED DEGREE - ARMY HIGHER EDUCATION PATHWAY

Instead of heading off to university, students can get a fully-funded degree with the Army. The 42 weeks' training at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst counts towards a BSc in Leadership and Strategic Studies, from the Henley Business School and the University of Reading. Students can carry on with their studies alongside their career beyond the academy, and they will not have to pay any fees.

MUSIC BURSARY - UP TO £9,250

For a 4 year commitment to British Army Music, we are offering a bursary of up to £9,250 per year for up to a 3 year period to offset tuition fees during students studies. Students must be studying a Bachelors or Master's degree in Music Performance at a British university or conservatoire. Alongside their studies, they will be encouraged to attend frequent Army band events throughout the year.

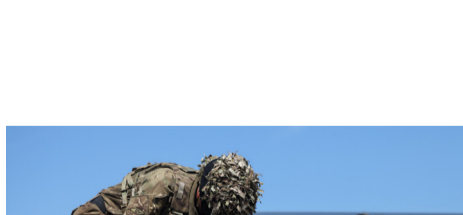

Petroleum Operator

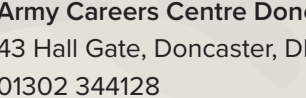
